- We have recruited a network Paramedic who will be mentored by Matron Isabel Vickers at Robin Lane. Her name is Leilah Nolan and will be starting at the end of January all being well
- Our second social prescriber, Bethany Reilly will also be starting in the New Year forming a mini Social Prescribing MDT with Nicola Greaves
- Our advert for an Operations Assistant went out to NHS Jobs on 12<sup>th</sup> December (closing date is 30<sup>th</sup> December) with an interviewing date of 13<sup>th</sup> January
- Our team of Network pharmacists have been working together on our PCN Quality Improvement Scheme (QIS) obligations with regards to Serious Mental Illness and Learning Disabilities (SMI and LD). This work will be ongoing and across each site within our Network. Our pharmacists meet often to discuss workstreams to make sure they are delivering what our Network needs

- Gables Open Day 13<sup>th</sup> December; in conjunction with their PPG, the Gables held an open day celebrating 4 years in their shiny new building! There were lots of Christmas jumpers, mince pies and smiles. And a raffle hamper!
- New Coils and Implants clinic – weekends at the Gables on the Hub. Two experienced female GPs have started to run these clinics from 7<sup>th</sup> December on a Saturday morning. Admin / reception / care navigation staff can book straight into the slots called “assessment” but the actual procedures can only be booked by the GP running the clinic.
- Virtual Pharmacist at the Hub in 2020; coming soon, Hub pharmacists will be able to run Virtual clinics (i.e, not face to face clinics. For example medication reviews done via telephone remotely
